Background

The Yyteri dune area suffers from anthropogenic erosion caused by now forbidden large events organised in the recent years. As a result some areas of the protected dunes are in danger to become extinct. The Yyteri dune area also suffers from invasive species and overgrowth which is boosted by large amounts of sea algae and nutritients arriving from sea to the shoreline every summer and fall
